PARAMEDIC AMBULANCE

JOB SUMMARY: Working with a partner in an ambulance and under the general supervision of a station officer, performs basic and advanced life support to patients during inter-facility transfer and victims of injury or illness. This is specialized work performed in accordance with Department, County, State, national and industry standards. Persons hired in this position are required to achieve and maintain certification as a Utah Paramedic and a Utah State driver's license.

Experience and Training: Graduate from high school or possess GED Certificate. Currently registered as an EMT/Paramedic by the State of Utah, Department of Health, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services (BEMS). Valid Utah Driver's License.

DUTIES: Provides emergency medical care at the scene, en route to the hospital and during transportation from facility-to-facility and emergency medical care as appropriate to the practice of the registered paramedic. Delivers the patient to the most appropriate medical facility. Adheres to Department, local, County, and State guidelines regarding patient care. Performs indicated Advanced Life Support (ALS) procedures as per the appropriate protocols under the direction and supervision of the Medical Control Physician, through standing orders, radio, or telephone communications. Ability to work effectively with minimal supervision, using good judgment and common-sense with a thorough understanding of the principles of emergency medical care at the paramedic level. Ensures that the vehicle and equipment are ready for use.

SCHEDULE: This will be a 40 hour per week position Tuesday through Saturday 1100 to 1900 hours.

TESTING PROCESS: Qualified applicants will be contacted to schedule the Job Simulation Test. Applicants that pass the Job Simulation Test will take a Personality Profile test. Applicants will then participate in an Oral Interview.

SALARY: The position is FLSA: Non-Exempt. The salary ranges with steps are:
